"This little Light of mine is going to shine, going to shine, going to shine."

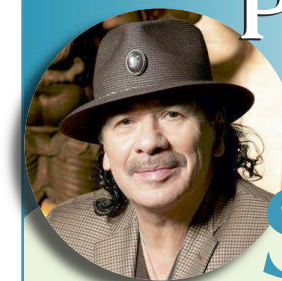
How about letting the Light in each of us shine the fearful images of fear that come from our ego minds away and become free again.

Miracle Musings...

A Clean Towel

How instantly the memory of God arises in the mind that has no fear to keep the memory away!" (T28.1.13)

"It was the best of times, it was the worst of times," so begins the great Dickens novel, *A Tale of Two Cities*. 2013 has been that kind of year for me. The "best of times" was both MDC conferences, one in Boston and the other in Irvine. Lots of good vibes as we Course students learned how to integrate its principles into our lives bringing us healing and transformation, happiness, and purpose. Then there's our inner-city youth chorus, **KidSingers** (of which I am the founder-director). Each year over one hundred at-risk kids join in a constructive after-school activity that teaches values of responsibility and self-worth as they learn to sing together and perform around the county. College scholarship money was awarded to thirteen **KidSingers** at our Spring Concert. A very successful benefit fundraiser was held in June to maintain this program as it goes into its seventeenth year. Plus, we held auditions to recruit new kids into the program as it continues to impact youth in such a profound way.

The "worst of times" started in February when I had the opportunity of doing a little medical procedure called a colonoscopy. For those of you who are familiar with this procedure, you'll know that the preparation for this very personal experience is oftentimes more taxing than the actual procedure. Within twenty four hours of the colonoscopy, I had to drink about a gallon of colyte solution, at strategic intervals of time, to flush my system out so there were no obstructions for the long, flexible instrument called a colonoscope to enter my body and get a good view of my insides. This may qualify as TMI, but stick with me.

With my wife Beverly at my side, I was

in the hospital for the procedure, all prepped, hooked up and ready to go, when the nurse suddenly announced, "You have an irregular heartbeat. Atrial fibrillation. With your heart in that condition, we can't do the colonoscopy now."

"What?!!!" was my response. "I've never had an irregular heartbeat. I just had a physical and no irregular heartbeat was found." But the die was already cast. We can't go against medical protocol.

The next thing you know we're visiting a cardiologist, who did agree with us that the colyte solution just may have caused the irregular heartbeat, but either way we now needed to correct the A-fib. He proceeded to inform me of my options, and I chose the very non-invasive course of action of

taking the drug digoxin (very little side effects) to see if it would assist my heart to self-correct. After about six months of this my heart had still not self-corrected, so I chose to go with another option: electrical cardioversion – restarting the heart to its regular rhythm through electrical shock. This was scheduled for October 3rd. Prep for this procedure was to start on blood thinners (warfarin) for the four weeks leading up to the procedure.

About the same time we were deciding on the electrical cardioversion, I sprained my ankle. After three weeks and my x-rays not showing any fracture, I finally got into an orthopedic specialist. He promptly diagnosed me with severe ankle tendonitis and ordered me in a cast for five weeks. Because of the warfarin, I was prohibited from taking any anti-inflammatory medication, so that has slowed down the healing (and pain relieving) process. What a frustrating development!

So, I'm thinking, okay what else can go wrong? Well, just one more thing.

Just last week our ninth grade son, Jeffrey, came home from school as usual and told his mom how his day had gone. It seems his twenty-three-year-old, first year freshman English teacher had "punished" the whole class that day because they had received too many bad marks in her class... you know, for excessive talking – really "bad" things. Her "punishment," was to have the kids kneel on the floor for the entire class period of one and a half hours. Well, the kids were flabbergasted, but they obediently followed their teacher's order. After all, as the teacher so confidently told them, they brought this upon themselves. About forty-five minutes into their ordeal – and many comments from students like "my knees really hurt, can we get up now?" – the teacher finally let them stand, but not before she gave them additional bad marks for resting their little behinds on their heels while kneeling. If they had to move about the classroom, they had to crawl. However well intentioned this teacher was to gain control of her classroom, we felt this way of punishment was highly inappropriate, against the law in the State of California, and action on our part needed to be taken.

Our parental damage control shifted into high gear. After telephone calls,

emails, and personal visits to the school, Jeffrey was transferred to a more experienced English teacher. The "offending" teacher is just young and made a mistake. She is now being monitored in her classroom and will, hopefully, receive the appropriate guidance and training she needs.

This was kind of a breaking point for me, though. The straw that broke the camel's back. The Biblical story of Job kept coming to mind. He was after all a Godly man and then all of a sudden, according to the Bible, God and Satan started playing a cosmic game of "Who's your Daddy?" As a result of all his suffering, would Job eventually curse God and die? Would I allow all these challenges to get the best of me? After all, I am a good student of the Course, and I know how to handle all this "stuff" in my life. But the ego's voice kept asking me, what good is all this spirituality if you can't see deliverance from all this misery? Fear had crept in and was taking its toll.

Then, out of nowhere, it happened. I was negotiating my way out of the shower (with a cast on my leg, even taking a shower had become an ordeal); I reached for my towel and found a nice new clean, fluffy white towel on the rack. It was a little surprising to me because Beverly usually replaces them on Friday and this was Thursday. But there it was, and it was beautiful; the most beautiful towel I'd ever seen. And then it hit me, an overwhelming sense of gratitude for this clean towel. A simple act of it being replaced by my loving wife became a miracle to me. All my troubles seemed to have been wiped away. A clean towel! My little, angry, gray world shifted in color to new and vibrant hues. I was reduced to tears. Somebody out there really does care for me. It was just one of those moments. No words can express it.

So what had just happened to bring me out of my little hell into the immediate presence of heaven? If I had to put it into words, I'd have to say that fear had been replaced with an inexplicable "knowing" that everything was going to be all right. As the Course says, "He to Whom time is given offers thanks for every quiet instant given Him. For in that instant is God's memory allowed to offer all its treasures to the Son of God, for whom they have been kept. ...For in that instant does the Son of God do nothing that would make himself

afraid. How instantly the memory of God arises in the mind that has no fear to keep that memory away!" (T28.1.12&13)

What changed? I'd like to say it was as simple as my demanding of myself: "Mind, have no fear!" But, oh my, that's not the way it happened. Rather, I think it did happen as a result of my intention of leaving, if but just a little room, for the memory of God to replace fear. That "little

willingness" the Course so often talks about. Did I have doubts about when this most recent chain of unfortunate events would end? Yes. Did I occasionally judge my actions and beat myself up for not being "spiritual?" Yes. Did I give in to occasional fits of frustration and anger? Yes. But, did all that matter? No. When you experience a miracle, a shift in perception

Even though the Center was founded by Beverly and Richard Hutchinson, it has developed a life of its own. Part VI: 2013 and Beyond: A Miracle Odyssey!

"When you have accepted your mission to extend peace you will find peace, for by making it manifest you will see it."
(T-12. VII.11:1)

The question we are frequently asked at Miracle Distribution Center (MDC) is: "Where is the Center going? Where do you see it in the future?" My first reaction to this type of question is the thought from the Course that says, "A healed mind does not plan." (W-135.11:1) And yet, since we do not realize that our minds are healed, we do have a tendency to plan. The Course is not asking us to deny the world or our need to make plans, but it is asking us to plan nothing on our own. It cautions us in the text section entitled *Looking Within*, "Everything you behold without is a judgment of what you beheld within. If it is your judgment it will be wrong, for judgment is not your function."

If it is the judgment of the Holy Spirit it will be right, for judgment is His function." So it is not so much whether one should plan or not plan, but with whom he will make his plans.

Our goal at MDC is to always ask the Holy Spirit, "What would you have us do?" That does not mean we will always follow the path of peace, because "The power of decision is your one remaining freedom as a prisoner of this world." (T-12.VII.9:1) We are given the freedom to condemn or release, to accept our mission of extending peace or projecting a conflicted, confused purpose. It is easy to look around and see the constant change in people's and

organizations' purposes when they place the emphasis on things outside themselves. The Course asks us to look within and find that our purpose is to extend peace, and allow the Holy Spirit to direct the outward expression of that purpose. His direction will be clear and consistent, even in the confusion and conflict. His direction will not change for His direction *cannot* change.

The Center has been on a steady keel for the past thirty-five years. It is quite clear to us through the thousands of calls, emails, letters, and requests we receive each month, that we are exactly where we

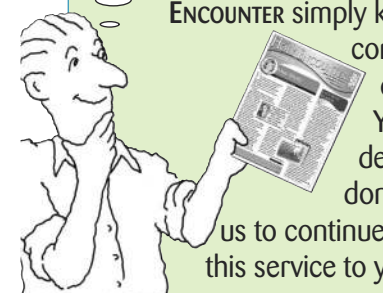

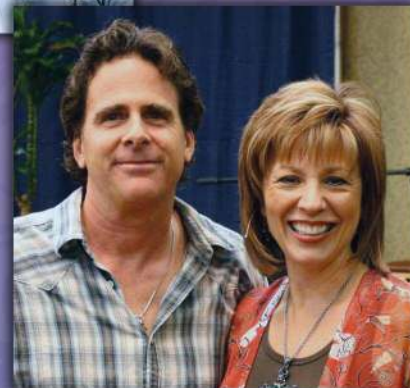

How Sweet the Sound

There is a compulsion within you to find the missing factor in your life, that which will restore to you your original nature of harmony, joy, and peace."

- Joel Goldsmith, Practicing the Presence

I believe that we long for and crave the Grace of God above all else. We are literally compelled to seek out and find something that is already right here, right now. In this very moment, all the Grace we yearn for is hidden just behind the thoughts that obsess over transitory things.

We live in a culture that is geared toward being or becoming a "somebody" when in fact, all our peace resides in being nobody. It is the idea of this fictional body-identified self that causes all the pain of our belief in separation and specialness. But it's just a thought — an unquestioned, stressful thought. And within this body-identification is all of our fear and all of our strategies for trying to "save" the body, care for the body, use the body, get things for the body - trying to keep it safe and alive and working is exhausting on every level. We are building sandcastles very close to the tide, wondering why we get so stressed out and tired.

To be "nobody" is actually to be everybody. This is not something to practice all day long every day. It doesn't need to become just another belief system to cling to. It is enough to bring it to mind once or twice a day through the great melting process within. I once heard a Shaman say that the ego is like an ice cube in a glass of

water, trying desperately not to melt - wanting to maintain the hard rigidity of "self" no matter what. Wanting to "get" what it needs at all costs. But there is another way.

My favorite movie is, "It's a Wonderful Life" with Jimmy Stewart. It's not just my favorite Christmas movie, it's my favorite movie of all time and has been for over 40 years. It's a story of the final acceptance of Grace. It's the opposite of the teaching of the world. George Bailey wants nothing more than to be a SOMEBODY and to do BIG THINGS with his life - to see the world and make a name for himself as an important architect. But not one of his dreams ever comes true in life. Not one. At that level, he is the very epitome of a complete and utter failure at everything he does. He lives a very small life in a very small town - so far from his dreams that he feels his life is worthless and too hard to continue another day. There has been no reward for all his hard work and sacrifice.

But he is visited by an Angel one night. Angels are the messengers of God. They are the introduction of Help from a thought system beyond our own. Our job is to LISTEN, LEARN and DO, based on the message given and this is often the extreme opposite of everything that the world is pointing us toward. This was the case with George. He had the wrong dream. Many people have the wrong dream for their lives. And like George, every door to his dream was nailed shut to him, while other doors kept on opening and opening for him to walk through. But as long as he clung to the wrong dream, all the beauty and wonder of his authentic life was lost on him. His Angel had to come and TELL HIM, "You see George, you really had a wonderful life!" When you have the right dream for your life, opportunities arise and doors open. They are NOT opportunities that compromise your integrity or doors that open to anything destructive. When those

doors open, your Guidance System within goes off and you KNOW you have no business walking through that door.

The Course tells us that the miracles we extend may touch many people we will never meet or know anything about. That is none of our business. In fact, in the movie, Mr. Potter is the "make life happen" kind of guy who forces all of his dreams to come true by seizing every opportunity he sees to move himself farther along toward his

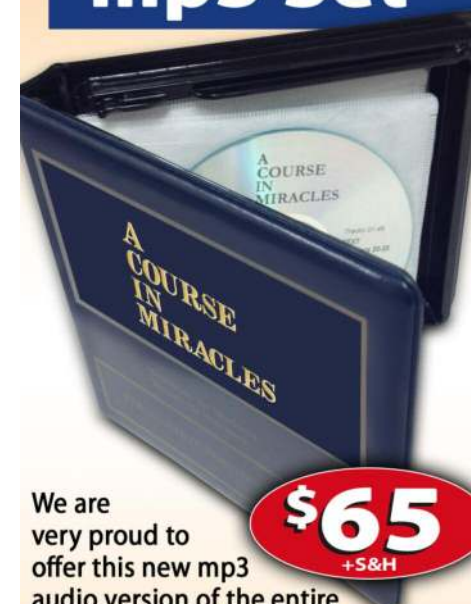
goals. And in some other movie an Angel might have come and shown him that he really had a miserable life - devoid of any love, joy or peace — even though that is what he was desperately searching for through impossible means. He had worldly power but nothing miraculous was happening for him or through him. That's why he wanted to hire George — to be near that Consciousness. Today, he would have offered George his own reality show and franchise line for starters. George WANTED to sell out . . . but his Soul would not allow it. The integrity of his authentic life was too strong. Remember, "the call to God is so strong that the ego literally dissolves at its sound."

Amazing Grace, how sweet the sound. It saves us — from ourselves and our insane thinking. But the sound of Grace is usually subtle and soft. It is lost on minds obsessed with making a SPLASH and BEING SOMEBODY WHO DOES BIG THINGS in the ego sense. George found

out that all the little things he'd been doing on a daily basis in his simple mediocre average life added up to an incredible chain of life-altering effects that rippled throughout not just his dull little town but even across the seas. Grace is like that.

We all have deep longing within us. The ego channels that longing and fools us into thinking the longing is for people, places, things and conditions. But the longing is really for Self. And that is already here. It's so simple and we MAKE it so hard. Simply meditate and pray ... and then keep walking through the open doors. ✨

Forgiveness is My Reputation

This column shares the everyday “miracles” or, as *A Course in Miracles* says, the “shifts in our perception” that are constantly taking place in our lives to remind us of our unity and love. We invite readers to share their “miracles” with us.

At that precise moment, I realized that I had not only learned the true power of forgiveness, but turned an important corner in my life, a milestone. Things became instantly more clear. The true “miracle” is to simply let God be in charge, and to wipe the grime of the ego from our eyes so we can begin to see the Light.

the books but most specifically in three workbook lessons which are each entitled: “I am as God created me.”

These lessons are the story of all of us. It is the realization that our Father has created us eternally, with strength, love, light, and holiness. We are complete with nothing missing, nothing that has sinned or could have made an image to replace reality. God’s loving answer stands beside us and gently helps us to look at our fear of going “down the toilet” of the world and invites us to instead affirm “I am as God created me. His Son can suffer nothing. And I am His Son.” It is asking us to lay aside the images we hold of God, others, and ourselves, so that the truth of our being might be known to us. Illusions cannot stop the mighty power of God. The Course asks us to look clearly at the illusions of fear and separation, holding the hand of God, and move past them. This process it says “is the birthplace of miracles, the great restorer of the truth to the awareness of the world.” (L110.5:2)

But how do we live this truth in our world? There certainly are people who do not know they are “as God created them” living in this world. Those who attack and murder certainly are not aware of Who they are. When we attack or judge others, we clearly believe another story than the truth God knows about us.

The Course is uncompromising. It says this entire world of form (and that includes our bodies) is not real. In fact, it says it simply does not exist. For most of us, though, this illusion (and our bodies) still seems very real. I always chuckle a little when earnest Course students tell other students “you are not a body and you have to stop making the body real” while they are hunting for the most comfortable chair to put their “unreal” bottoms into. Frankly, if you are taking a breath right now, you believe you are a body. We are not asked to deny what we still value but to begin the process of looking at it with the help of the Holy Spirit. He knows how to help us release the illusions so that truth may prevail. We will never release anything as long as we value it. The purpose of the presence of God in our minds is to help us

see how much more peaceful our lives will be when we are willing to withdraw our value from fear in favor of love.

I remember when Jeffrey was about six years old he could not fall sleep without his favorite blanket. This blanket went everywhere with us. One time on a beach trip I must have accidentally left the blanket in the bed sheets in the motel room. Frankly the blanket had gotten so worn it looked like an old sheet. When we got home, I panicked. I didn’t tell Jeffrey about the missing blanket. I just hunted for it, called the motel, and even told Paul that he might have to drive back to the beach for the blanket — this comment was not a welcomed idea! Finally I sat down with Jeffrey and told him what happened and that it looked like the blanket was lost. Instead of the tears I thought I would see, he simply said okay and went on playing. He ended up finding another blanket that night, but no blanket was ever needed again the way that old blanket was.

The Course keeps reminding us that truth is working even if we can’t see the results. How could it be otherwise? There is only the loving Will of God. We will awaken to our oneness with each other; we will know our Home in God. As the Course tells us, “God is inevitable, and you cannot avoid Him any more than He can avoid you.” (T4.1.9) How much we delay, however, does not change the real story about us. We’ll get there and the Course offers us help.

The question is: How long will we allow an “alien will” (which is how the Course refers to our mistaken ego mind) to oppose God’s Will? By calmly looking at what frightens us, makes us angry, or seems to be the thing we can’t live without, we can begin the process of taking the

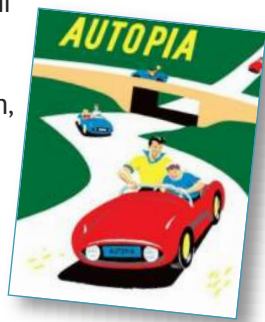
value away from what no longer serves us. This process combined with our willingness to stay focused on God’s Will for us, allows us to experience the miracles we are entitled to.

Hugh Prather once wrote, “Letting the day dictate our mood is a decision.” It is now time for us to stop our passive aggressive attitudes. We feel frustrated because we think we are victims of our circumstances, but we are allowing those circumstances to control us by our decision to act powerless. We may not be able to change the circumstance in which we find ourselves, but we can and must take responsibility for our thoughts and how we think about those circumstances if we ever hope to escape them. We have the power to choose how we will respond in every situation. If everything is our decision either to take charge or give up, which one makes more sense to do?

The following are three suggestions to help you experience your real story by taking charge in a way that allows you to detach from illusions and focus on the truth.

1. “Be vigilant only for God and His Kingdom.” (T6.V.C) This might sound pretty hard to do given our undisciplined nature, but the longest journey begins with the first step. The process is really more about turning in the direction of truth and not allowing distractions to divert you. For example, make every effort to do a workbook lesson every day; even if you don’t think you did it well enough, it worked. It’s not so much about how well you do something but that you begin to set a pattern in your mind.

Have you ever driven the Autopia at Disneyland? They are small cars on a very loose track. If you steer straight and keep vigilant the ride is smooth, but if you don’t pay attention or take your hands off the wheel, while you don’t crash, it’s a jerky ride. That’s like us. We think we are independent, but we are really on God’s

track and we can't crash. When we go with His flow and steer ourselves with vigilance toward His Will and our place in His Kingdom, it's a smooth ride. We may occasionally veer off course but we can never lose our way.

2. "Creation's gentleness is all I see." (L265) It is a complete mind reversal to realize that the world is a projection of our thinking, and it can be somewhat guilt-inducing to our untrained minds. Our egos love to say, "Look at the mess you've made!" But Spirit asks us to see this illusion with gentleness and say, "What I see is a mistaken thought in my mind, and I choose to *let no appearance of my mistakes obscure the light of Heaven shining on the world. The images I see reflect my thoughts. Yet is my mind at one with God's. And so I*

3. "...to heal and comfort and to bless." (T31.VI.1:8) The Course tells us that salvation is the undoing of the world of form; when we remove the blocks to the awareness of love, then there is love. The question is: how do we undo the world of form while it still has value to us? "Salvation does not ask that you behold the spirit and perceive the body not. It merely asks that this should be your choice." (ibid) As we hold this choice in mind, the Course continues with this practical advice, "...choose the spirit, and all Heaven bends to touch your

can perceive creation's gentleness." (ibid) This way of thinking allows us grace to look at the world and not be stopped by its fearful, distorted images. We see clearly that beyond this "call for love" is love. Our focus then moves from the guilt or disgust that we may have initially felt to compassion and gentleness for ourselves and all of God's children.

eyes and bless your holy sight, that you may see the world of flesh no more except to heal and comfort and to bless." (ibid) In order to transcend this world we must be fully present in this world so that we may be the hands to heal, the heart to comfort, and the eyes to bless. We are asked to be in the world, but not of the world; to be a teacher of God who is cognizant of his mission of healing wherever he might find himself. What greater purpose could we have than to heal, comfort, and to bless?

That's the story behind every one of us, and it's a story that truly makes us lovable. We are here to remember Who we are, to be gentle to everyone as well as ourselves in the process, and to heal, comfort, and bless while we abide where we are not at home.

As this year draws to a close, we'll get plenty of opportunities to see fear, guilt and attack in a world of illusions, but illusions can't stop us because they are illusions. We are children of God; that's our common ground, that's our story. And, in the end, that's our inevitable salvation. ✨

as the Course defines a miracle, nothing in the past matters. All that matters was, as in the old Biblical story, "I was blind but now I see!"

What am I saying? Just this: As we journey through this world we are in a process of remembering who we are and what our inheritance is as the Son of God. In that process we encounter many "good things" and "bad things." But when a bad thing allows you to have a new perception of the eternal and of our wholeness and of our healing, is it really a bad thing? The Course tells us we should not judge, because when we do, we inflict that judgment back upon ourselves and that makes us weary. Judging ourselves for losing our temper or not being spiritual enough, or losing our peace, are all exercises in futility and, therefore, nothing. They don't damn us; they just give us another opportunity to choose once again. In our choosing once again, we have

the opportunity to choose to be merciful to ourselves and not judgmental. "God offers only mercy. Your words should reflect only mercy, because that is what you have received and that is what you should give." (T3.VI.6)
